Tuition

Pupils are entitled to a 30 minute lesson in a small group of no more than 3. Individual lessons are a minimum of 15 minutes duration. The tutor will be available to teach a minimum of 30 lessons per academic year (10 per term on average).

Instruments are available from MOD Schools Music Service and are loaned to students at a nominal charge whilst they are receiving tuition.

The instrumental tuition comes as a package consisting of two main elements:

Firstly, the pupil will receive small group lessons in his/her own school during the school week. All of our staff are highly qualified instrumental specialists.

Secondly, after an initial period of tuition, the pupil will be expected to attend an ensemble which will operate at a Music Centre in their Sovereign Base Area. These practical activities operate at various times during the week, outside normal school hours. It is there that the pupil will experience playing in larger bands, orchestras and other instrumental ensembles.

The MOD Music Service primarily offers tuition in woodwind, brass and bowed string instruments. However, should timetabling, staffing and schools permit, we will always consider applications for other instruments. At present tuition is available for pupils in Year 3 and above.

Please complete this application form and we may be able to help. Every child will then be given a suitability test, but tuition will not commence until all completed documentation is received at the Music Service office.
